# SUMMARY

This strategic plan utilizes a four-part time frame for implementation of goals: short term, intermediate, long term, and ongoing.

**Short term** - are currently underway or to be implemented and anticipated for completion between October 1, 2025, and September 30, 2026.

**Intermediate** - are expected to be implemented and anticipated for completion between October 1, 2026, and September 30, 2028.

**Long term** - are expected to be implemented and anticipated for completion between October 1, 2028, and September 30, 2029.

**Ongoing** - refers to objectives which, once implemented, will be continued indefinitely by Sheriff's Office personnel.

Performance measures or success will be quantified by assigned members submitting quarterly reports to document the progress made toward achievement of the stated objective, significant problems associated with its achievement, and any significant deviation from the approved implementation plan.

The plan shall be reviewed and updated each year to reflect changes in crime patterns, citizen and agency expectations and needs, demographics, and economic conditions in Sarasota County.
